AQUATICS CENTER GENERAL RULES

- **Lifeguard On Duty Policy:** Access to the pool(s) is only permitted when a lifeguard is on duty. If you have a swim lesson, please make sure to be accompanied by a Swim Instructor.
- **Lifeguard Authority:** Our lifeguards have the authority to enforce all safety rules and Center policies. Please respect their instructions and guidance at all times.
- **Shower Requirement:** Before entering the pool, all participants are required by law to shower. This helps maintain a clean and hygienic environment for everyone.
- **Swimming Attire Guidelines:** Proper swimming attire is required for all swimmers and individuals entering the pool area. Acceptable attire includes one- and two-piece swimsuits, swim trunks or briefs, and water shirts. Religious and modesty swimwear is allowed as long as it is designed for in-water use. Street clothes, athletic and workout attire, undergarments, and revealing or see-through suits are NOT permitted. Our Aquatics staff reserves the right to enforce these guidelines and determine whether swimwear meets the requirements.
- **Swim Diaper Requirement:** Children who are not yet potty trained must wear a swim diaper designed for immersion in water. This swim diaper should be covered with a rubber pant. Additionally, children are required to wear appropriate swim attire over the rubber pant.
- **Footwear Policy:** Street shoes are not allowed on the pool deck. Please wear proper pool shoes or flip-flops in all wet areas to ensure a clean and safe environment.
- **Food, Beverage, and Chewing Gum:** Food, beverages (except for water in plastic bottles), and chewing gum are not permitted in the pool area. Please dispose of any water bottles upon exiting the pool area.
- **Drugs, Alcohol, and Tobacco Products:** The use of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products (including electronic smoking devices) is strictly prohibited in the Aquatics Center.
- **Glass Containers:** Glass containers of any kind are prohibited in the Aquatics Center.
- **Use of Electrical Devices:** Electrical devices such as cell phones, tablets, speakers, and other electronics are prohibited inside the pools. They must be kept at least three (3) feet from the pool's edge.
- **Unauthorized Use of Video, Photography, and Recording Devices:** Use of video, photography, and recording devices without authorization is prohibited in the Aquatics area. However, photographs focused solely on your family members are permitted with the permission of a Swim Instructor or Lifeguard.
- **Diving and Horseplay:** To prevent accidents and injuries, diving, running, jumping, splashing, and shoving are strictly prohibited in and around the pool area.
- **Hygiene Practices:** Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, and regurgitating pool water are not prohibited.
- **Proper Behavior:** We expect all participants to display appropriate behavior while at the Aquatics Center. Profanity, improper conduct, and intoxication are not tolerated. Anyone suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be prohibited from entering the water.
- **Communicable Diseases:** Any person who shows signs of a communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease, will be denied admission into the pools.
- **Animals Policy:** Only service animals are permitted in the Aquatics Center.
- **Electrical Storm Safety:** For your safety, swimming is prohibited during an electrical storm.
- **Closing Time:** All individuals must exit the Aquatics Center at least 30 minutes prior to the Center's closure.
